I. INTRODUCTIONS AND CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

II. APPROVAL OF NOVEMBER 17, 2016 MEETING MINUTES

Action: It was moved by Shayne Morgan and seconded by David Peaton to approve the minutes as written. The motion carried unanimously.

III. NEW BUSINESS

The addition of a second training trailer was discussed. One suggestion is to divide the equipment equally and have one serve the north and one the south. Training props could include rail car domes and a "C-kit."

The policy board discussed the Hazardous Materials Response team assessment strategy and agreed that it should be conducted for all teams. The upcoming Hazmat-IQ class and other training opportunities were discussed.

Dwayne Mundy reported that the expansion of Levy County joining the Regional Hazmat Team is still on hold until the regional planning council issue with Marion County is resolved. Staff reported that he would try again to resolve this issue.

IV. CLOSEOUT OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANT GRANT FOR PIPELINE SAFETY

Remaining tasks included stocking the trailer and building pipeline leak trees.

The group discussed options for remaining involved with pipeline planning after the competition of the U.S. Department of Transportation Technical Assistance Grant.
